It is my pleasure to invite you to attend two (2) upcoming Beneficiary Consultation meetings. The first is a meeting to discuss the process to make a portion of our Pu'unēnē lands in Central Maui available for revenue generation, as provided in the Maui Island Plan. The Hawaiian Homes Commission Act provides the Commission with the authority to take some of its lands and use them to generate revenue for homesteading and community initiatives. We have major revenue generating lands on O'ahu and Hawai'i Island, but this will be the first major revenue generating project on Maui. The details for this meeting are as follows:

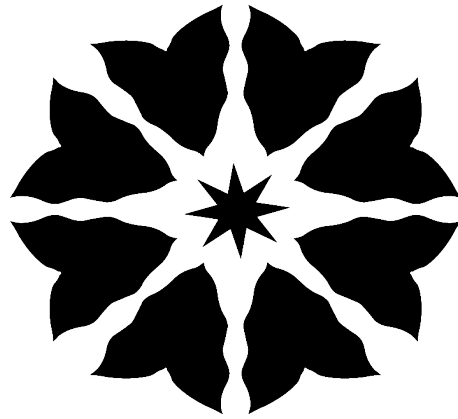
