HAWAII COUNTY'S WASTERWATER PROJECT TO BEGIN SOON

The Wastewater department and their consultants will be back in our community on July 18, 2012 our next meeting. They will share some of the details about the renewed efforts to retrofit the "old" sewer lines beginning at around Keaa Street (near Mazda) and eventually ending up at the pumping station on Kalaniana'ole Ave. Keaukaha Community showed me and those from the Wastewater division that we are a community **unified** in our efforts to be heard and reach resolutions for the **betterment of the conditions of our native Hawaiians in Keaukaha.** The work to be done may take up to a year to complete and there will be a detour into our community using Nahale-a Street from Kauhane Street to Baker Ave. There are other things such as a one-way traffic leading out of our community, what needs to be

planned in the event of an emergency, control traffic with people unfamiliar with our community, school traffic and anything else that may IMPACT KEAUKAHA. Your **mana'o** about how any of these things may have an impact on your lives here in Keaukaha is greatly appreciated. SITUATION AT KE ANA LAAHANA PCS

We have vacated the building at Pa Hoaka (near 4 miles), per letter received by the LSB (Local School Board) while the Edith Kanakaole Foundation (EKF) and the County of Hawaii conducts an inspection of the buildings. We have cleared and put into storage all of Ke Ana's ukana (things) while awaiting word on whether we can return to the site or even if it is still available. We are still waiting to hear about the compliance inspection of the building at Pa Hoaka of our community school of Ke Ana Laahana. We realize that school will start shortly and I have not provided any new information about whether or not the inspections of the building at Pa Hoaka are completed. As soon as
