#### What is the BLITZ BUILD?

In celebration of our 10th Anniversary, Habitat for Humanity West Hawaii has partnered with Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, Blitz Home Builders, and the Office of Hawaiian Affairs to build **5 HOMES IN 10 DAYS** at La'i 'Opua in Kailua-Kona, Hawaii (right across from Kealakehe High School). It will take place from September 12 through September 22, 2012.

# How can we be a part of it?

### There are many ways you can be a part of this Blitz Build:

Monetary Sponsorship: 100% of your donation will go towards the cost to build the 5 homes. **In-kind Donations**: If you can't donate monetarily but still want to help, we could use supplies for the build. Here is a short list of what we need during the Blitz Build:

**Lunch Sponsorship:** Meals will be provided for at least 300 people every day at the build. We are in need of businesses/groups that would like to donate monetary/in-kind to our lunch fund or may be interested in donating a meal. We are looking for simple lunches – sandwiches, chili and rice, or pizzas are just some examples.

**Build Volunteers**: We will need volunteers in a variety of areas – carpentry, electrical, drywall, plumbing, painting, concrete, roofing, landscaping - at every skill level.

**Medical Volunteers**: Medically-trained personnel would be needed on-site daily.

**Registration Volunteers:** Volunteers will be needed daily to check in/out the volunteers.

**Hospitality Volunteers:** Greeters will be needed daily to welcome all the volunteers and to check-in with them throughout the day. You will also help prepare the meals and help in the food tent daily.

**Traffic/Parking:** Volunteers will coordinate parking, drop off area for supplies, and keep the traffic flowing smoothly around the build site.

**Security:** Security personnel to watch over the build site during and after the build hours during the blitz.

#### Your church may want to take part in the APOSTLES BUILD:

The Apostles Build is a partnership that allows twelve (or more) individual churches join together to build and fund a home for a local family. As Jesus' original apostles were charged with spreading the word about Him, our twelve apostles are charged with assisting in Habitat's mission to provide shelter for God's children.
