

The Molokai Outreach Program affords students the opportunity to major in and to earn certificates and degrees primarily in four program areas: Liberal Arts (A.A.), Agriculture and Natural Resources (A.A.S.), Business Careers (A.A.S.), and Human Services (A.S.). Within the A.A.S. and A.S. degree programs, students may earn a variety of certificates including the Certificate of Competence (CertCO), Certificate of Completion (C.C.), and Certificate of Achievement (C.A.) as they work towards their associate degrees.

Molokai students may also earn the Academic Subject Certificate in Hawaiian Studies (A.S.C.) which is intended to provide students with a strong foundation in the culture, language, and philosophy of the Native Hawaiian people.

In addition, students may also major in **Nurse Aide Training** and earn a Certificate of Competence (CertCO) but cannot advance further in nursing at this time without leaving the island.

Lastly, Molokai students may choose to take classes and major in programs which are not listed above but are available to all Maui Community College students. However, students will need to plan well and are encouraged to meet with their counselors as the complete sequence of required and elective courses for the major may not be offered on Molokai.
