# WAIOHULI HIKINA, MAUI VACANT LOTS

Waiohuli Hikina subdivision is located on a 37.3 acre parcel of land on the western slopes of Haleakalā within the Kula district on the island of Maui. This infill project is sited within the Kula Residence Lots Unit 1 subdivision. Waiohuli Hikina's rural qualities are characterized by a clean environment, abundant outdoor recreational opportunities, vast open spaces, natural resources and a rich cultural heritage.

# CLIMATE

Temperatures range from the low 50s during the winter to the mid-80s during the summer

# PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

SOIL: Stony silt loam—cobbly loam

**WATER:** Potable County water system with fire protection

RAINFALL: 20-30 inches a year

**ELEVATION:** 2,400–2,800 feet above sea level

**SLOPE:** Approximately 3%–20 %

**DRAINAGE:** Natural slopes and well-draining soils provide adequate drainage

FLOOD ZONE: Waiohuli Hikina is located outside the 500-year flood plain

**ROADS:** County Standard

**SEWER:** Individual wastewater systems
