SITE VISIT INFORMATION**

I. **KALAELOA, OAHU PARCELS**

A limited site visit will be conducted by Land Management Division staff on only the following date:

**Wednesday, March 14, 2018 at 9:30 am**

Meet at DHHL Headquarters Reception Area (Hale Kalanianaʻole) at 91-5420 Kapolei Parkway in Kapolei. Entrance to the parking lot is on Kinoiki Street, between the East Kapolei Fire Station and the DHHL Headquarters complex. Staff will brief participants on the tour before they proceed to the sites using their own respective vehicles. This will NOT be a comprehensive tour and may include only limited access through the parcels; it will primarily be viewing the parcels from certain vantage points.

II. **KAHIKINUI, MAUI PARCEL**

Piilani Highway bisects DHHL's Kahikinui parcel allowing Mauka and Makai views along the road. Kahikinui is isolated, expansive and rugged. You are cautioned that there are no rest areas, gas stations or stores along Piilani Highway in this region. Travel is at your own risk. Plan accordingly.

Kahikinui begins about where there should be a sign visible on the right side of Piilani Highway, just past the Auwahi Wind Project turbines which are on privately-owned land. The eastern boundary of Kahikinui is just before Manawainui Gulch.
