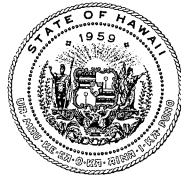

The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) Planning Office invites you and your 'ohana to attend an informational "talk-story" meeting regarding future DHHL Hanapēpē Homestead development and the related Hawai'i Revised Statute Chapter 343 environmental assessment (EA) process. DHHL intends to provide additional homestead opportunities on its undeveloped Hanapēpē lands for those beneficiaries that are still on the waiting list. The purpose of this meeting is to provide a chance to inform and consult with existing lessees regarding future homestead development in Hanapēpē. As Hanapēpē homestead lessees, we hope to learn from your insights regarding current conditions in the homestead area and the relationship of the people and place to the larger community of Hanapēpē and the island of Kaua'i.

We would also like to inform you that DHHL and its consultant SSFM International will be conducting a site visit of DHHL lands in Hanapēpē including the existing Hanapēpē homestead community the very next day **Friday, December 14, 2018**. The purpose of our site visit is to walk the land and experience the area. If you see us walking down your street, please feel free to come by and talk story with us too.

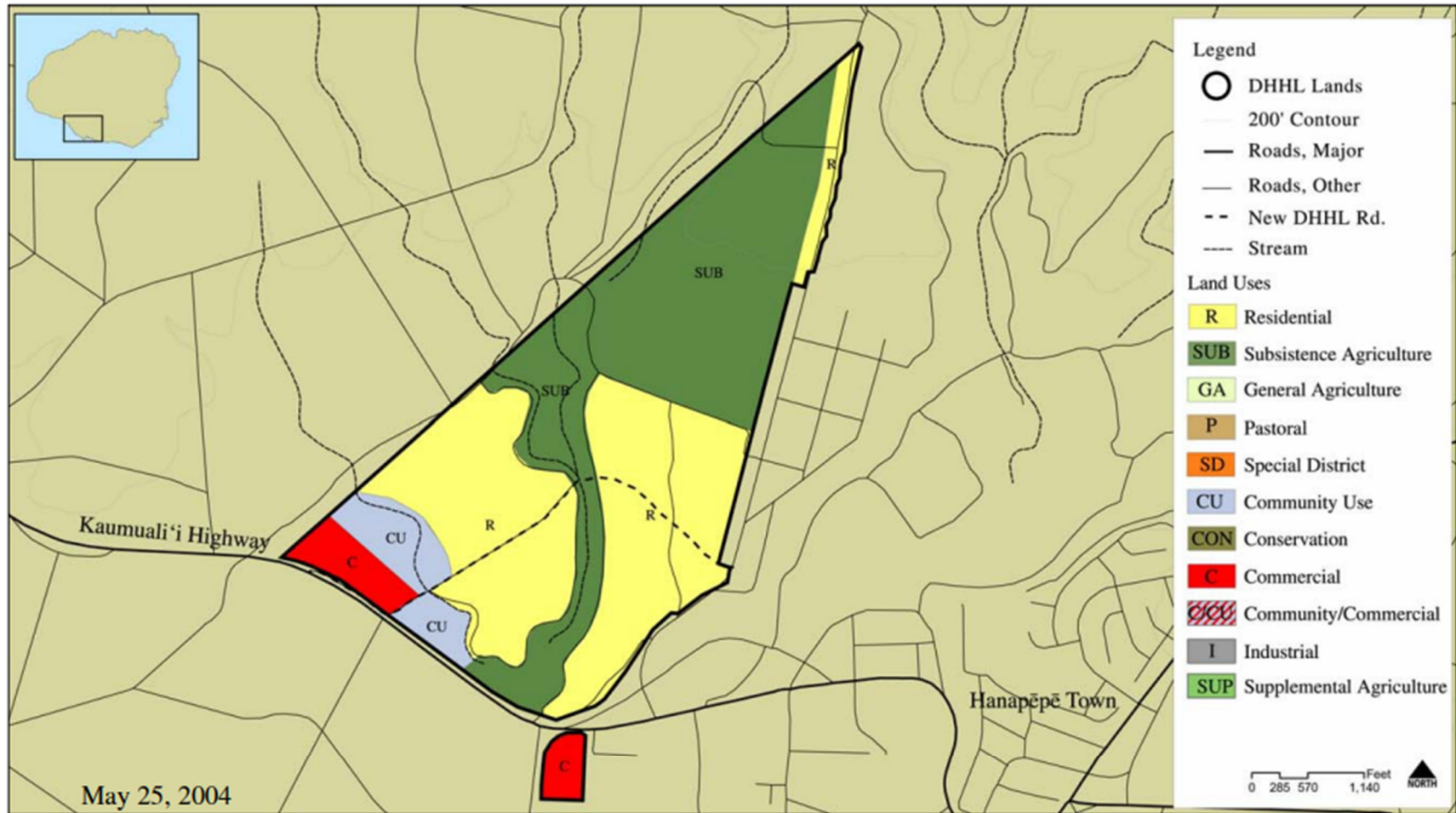
