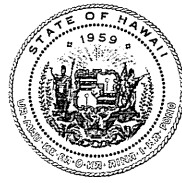

Aloha DHHL Kaua'i Beneficiary,

The Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL) will be conducting a Beneficiary Consultation meeting to gather your input for the development of a new homestead community on 365 acres of DHHL lands in Hanapēpē, Kaua'i. The project is envisioned as a mix of residential and subsistence agriculture homestead areas, along with areas for community use and commercial development. The project will be developed in two phases, and when completed it will be the largest residential and agricultural homestead community on Kaua'i's West Side (see the enclosed Fact Sheet for a project description and location map). The purpose of the project is to provide residential and subsistence agriculture homesteading opportunities to DHHL beneficiaries on the Kaua'i residential and agricultural waitlists within a well-planned community.
