On behalf of the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL), staff from G70 will be visiting the Malama Cultural Park on the dates listed above to collect relevant geographical and biological information to inform the development of a Special Area Plan.

Surveyors will be working during both daylight and nighttime hours. To protect the health and safety of the Moloka'i community, all necessary precautions will be taken, per the Hawai'i Safe Travels rules. Surveyors will wear masks and adhere to strict social distancing protocols. Surveyors will not be meeting with any members of the community during this visit and respectfully request that the community not approach surveyors while field work is taking place.

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

*The Hawaiian Homes Commission designated Malama Cultural Park as a Special District to preserve and protect the significant natural, historic and community resources present on site. DHHL will be developing a Special Area Plan to address Park concerns such as responsible access, facility and infrastructure management, and natural and cultural resource stewardship.*

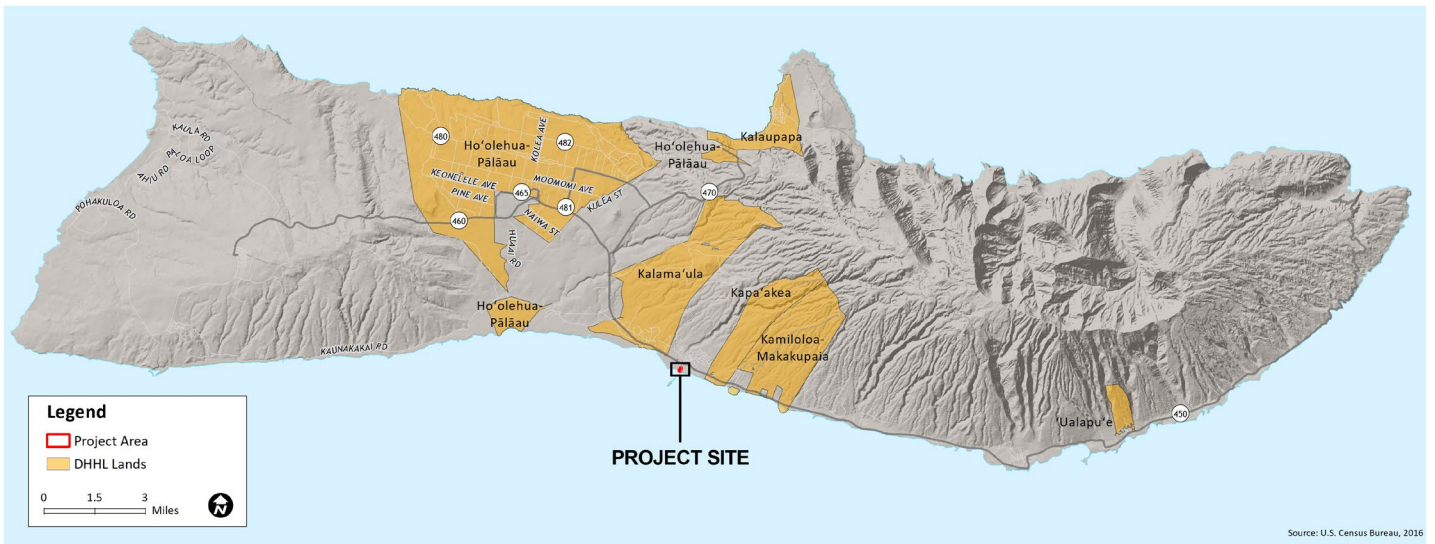

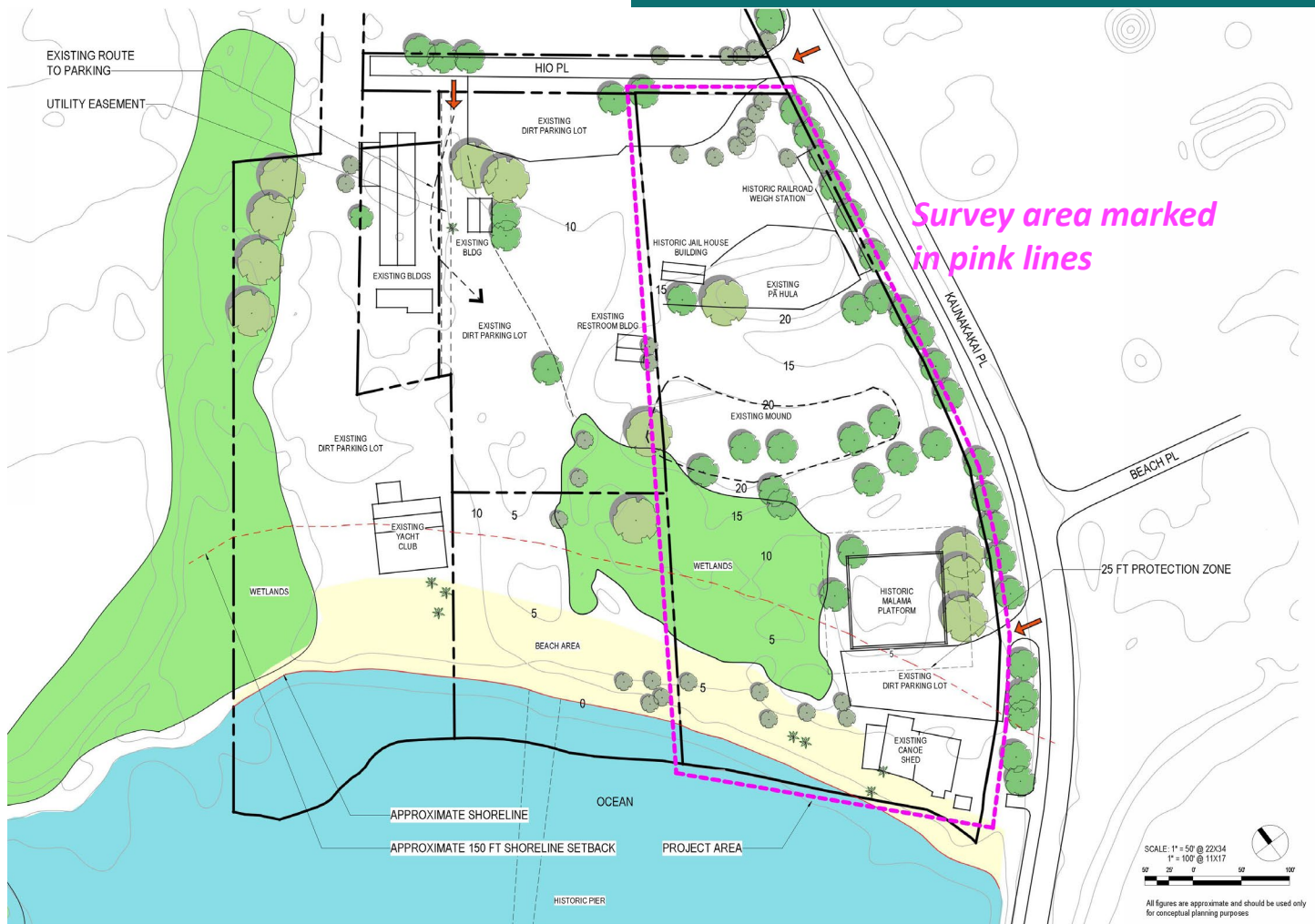
