

REQUESTS FOR CLARIFICATION

1. We are interested in submitting our qualifications for the Unmanned Aerial Vehicle Services solicitation. I was wondering if this contract will be awarded based on the ability to provide all the services listed under the General Scope of Services section, or if we could submit for a specific type of service only.

We would prefer to execute a contract with one firm to provide the range of services described in the solicitation. However, if no one firm can provide all the services, we could award multiple contracts.

3. If we submitted with other firms as sub-consultants to provide the services our firm is not able to fulfill, does each sub-consultant need to provide their own questionnaire attached to the proposal?

Yes.

4. Was there a format for how you wished to receive the hourly quotations for each of the described services?

Hourly rates are not requested in the responses to this solicitation. It is issued in accordance with Hawaii Revised Statute, Section 103D-304. Therefore, evaluation shall be based on the criteria as stated in the Notice to Providers of Professional Services only. A contract will be negotiated with the first ranked offeror including rates of compensation which are fair and reasonable.

5. Are there existing hour allocations for each type of service that we could utilize to estimate the total amount of post-processing?

The is no allocation by type of service. The contract will have a lump sum budget against which individual task orders will be drawn down. The scopes of services will be determined as needs arise. Proposed cost for each task order shall be submitted and approved before notice to proceed on the task is issued.

6. Are there any existing restrictions on manufacturers or countries of origin for unmanned aerial vehicles?

Equipment must comply with all Federal and State regulations. No additional restrictions by DHHL.
