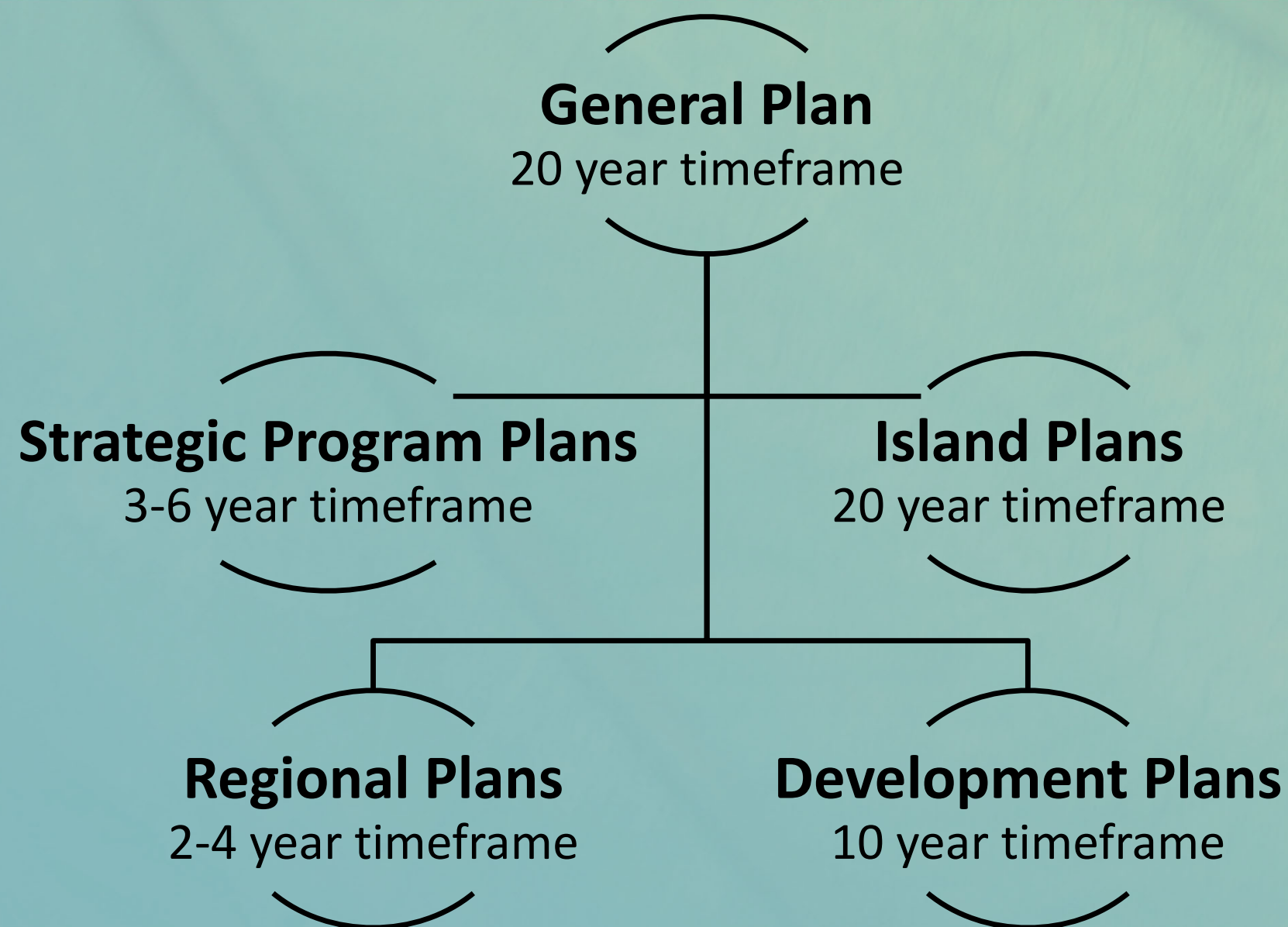

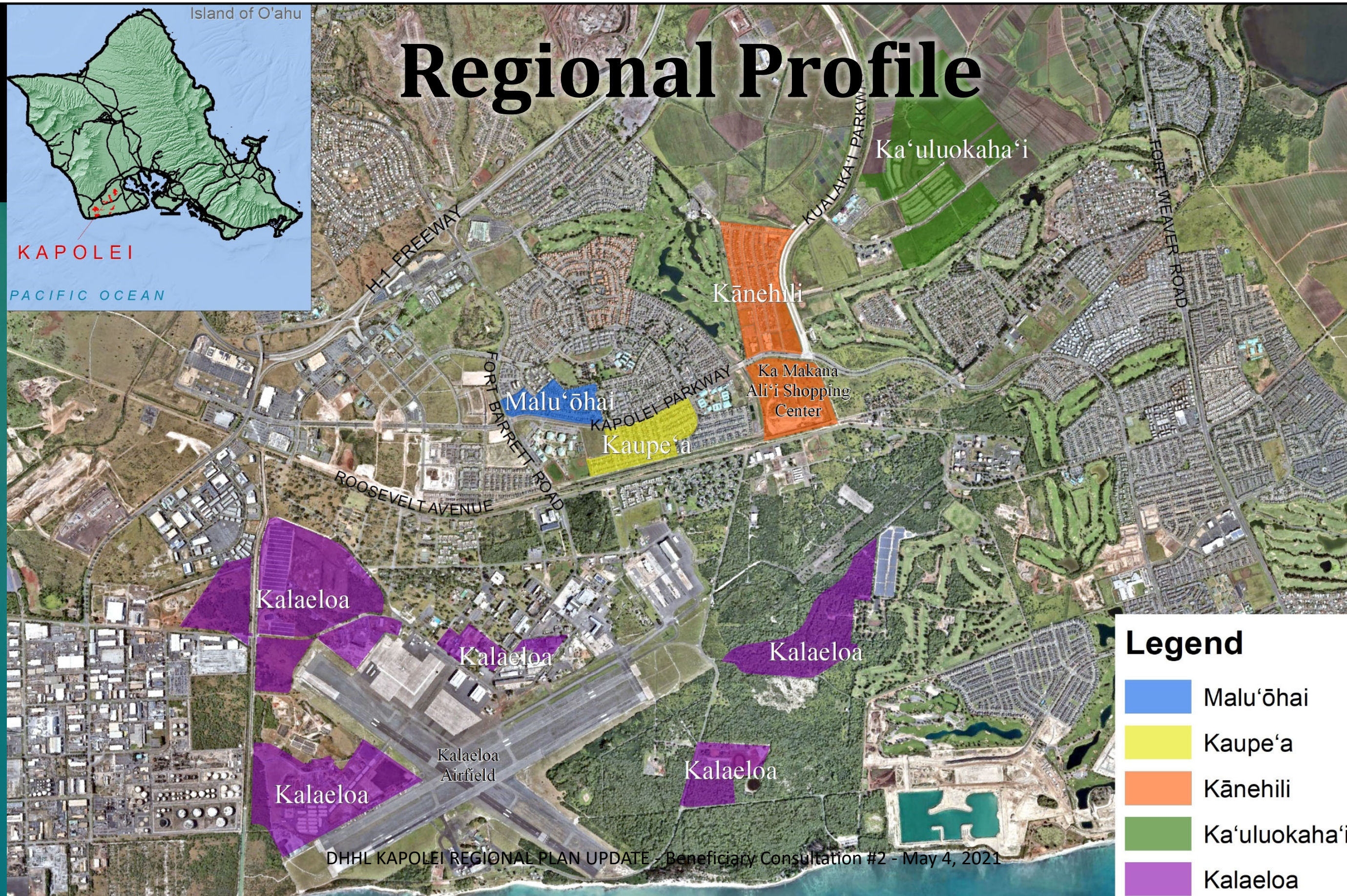


Values, Vision, Breakout Room Recap

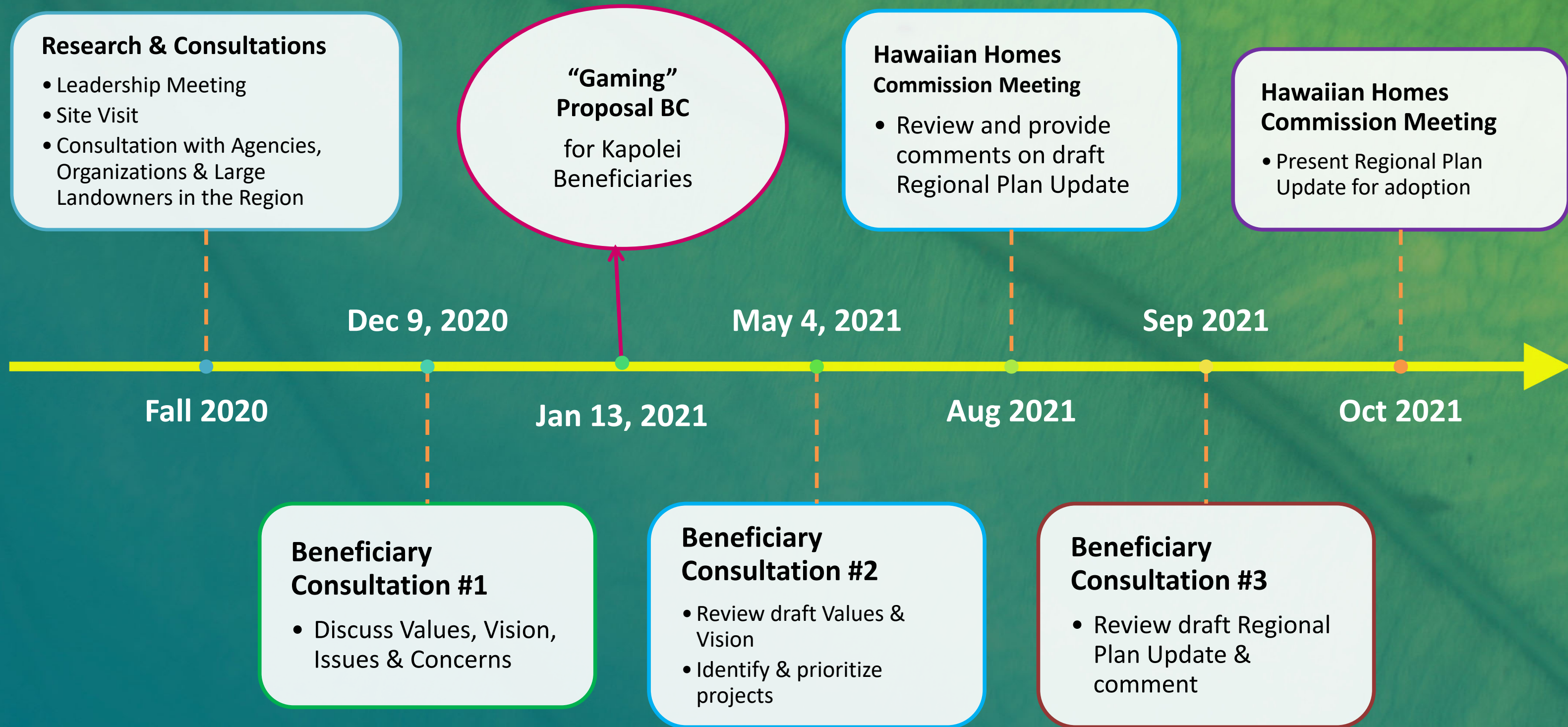
PROJECT PRIORITIZATION
