COVID-19 Building Entry Requirements: (Effective September 13, 2021)

Due to the ongoing pandemic, ensuring the protection of the government workforce and public is essential for continued operation and service to the public.

Entry Requirements:

- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination includes:
 - A CDC vaccination card;
 - VAMS (Vaccine Administration Management System) printout or certificate;
 - DOD DD Form 2766C;
 - State of Hawaii SMART Health Card;
 - Common Pass applications;
 - CLEAR Health Pass;
 - Azova;
 - IBM Digital Health Pass; or
 - Other similar products available to the public
- Exemptions to providing proof of vaccination includes:
 - Document of a negative COVID-19 test no more than 72 hours old;
 - Children under 12 years old; or
 - Individuals remaining 10 minutes or less
- Wear a face mask at all times while in the building
- Maintain proper social distancing while indoors
- If you have a cold, runny nose, sore throat, muscle aches or fever, please do not come into the facility. Contact a medical facility or your physician.
