2. Purpose of Pre-Bid Conference

- To provide potential bidders with a project overview and job site visit.
- To review procurement requirements and allow potential bidders to ask questions and obtain clarification on the bid documents. A written summary of this pre-bid conference will be issued as an Addendum.
- Requests for clarifications and any questions after this meeting shall be submitted in writing and uploaded on HHePRO no later than 2:00 pm, July 5, 2022, responses to all questions received will be posted on HHePRO at 4:00 pm, July 7, 2022.
- Required Notice of Intention to Bid, shall be e-mailed to sara.t.okuda@hawaii.gov by 2:00 pm, July 5, 2022,

3. Scope of Work

- This project consists of furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, and supervision for the periodic clearing and maintenance of brush and vegetative growth in the Village of La‘i ‘Ōpua. Work consists of cutting, moving, and trimming vegetative ground cover, and properly disposing of green waste and debris off-site from vacant lots, sidewalk planting strips, drainage ditches, drainable culverts, easements, and other common areas within the DHHL’s Villages of La‘i ‘Ōpua.
- Bi-yearly (every two years) clearing currently being done. Therefore, approximately monthly maintenance will be performed until June 2024, when the next bi-yearly clearing will be done.

4. Procurement reminders

- This project is not tax exempt. Your bid proposal must be inclusive of General Excise Tax.

- This project is subject to Chapter 104 HRS, Wages & Hours of Employees on Public Works.
 - Bid offer form shall be uploaded on HIEPRO before 2:00 pm, July 15, 2022.
 - After offer is due and prior to award of the contract, the Department shall verify compliance with Sections 103D-310 and 103D-328 HRS via Hawaii Compliance Express (HCE) for the bidder and all subcontractors. Therefore, the bidder and all subcontractors are encouraged to register with HCE. Instructions for registration are at the HCE website: <http://vendors.ehawaii.gov>.
 - Failure by the bidder and/or any subcontractor to rectify a non-compliant status on HCE within ten business days of notification will be considered as sufficient for the disqualification of the bidder and rejection of its proposal.
 - Award of contract will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive “Total Sum Bid”, approximately two weeks following bid opening and after certification of the bid tabulation.
5. Completion Schedule and Liquidated Damages
- Approximately monthly (about when vegetation reaches 1 foot) maintenance.
 - Time to complete: 30 calendar days from Notice to Proceed.
 - Liquidated damages: \$1,000.00 per calendar day.
 - Contract Time: 2 years, with 2 options to extend for 2 years each.
