### Overview of Open House

The purpose of the Anahola Regional Plan Update Draft Community Open House was to provide lessees and beneficiaries from the Anahola, Kamalomalo'o, and Moloa'a region the opportunity to review and comment on the draft regional plan update, including the draft priority projects. The open house was hosted by beneficiary led organization, Kahu O Ka Pāka Kahakai 'o Anahola, on the site the volunteer caretaker at Anahola Beach Park.

The open house stations mirrored the sections of the Regional Plan Update draft and the information presented was summarized from the draft text. Full copies of the plan were available for open house attendees to peruse and guests were invited to provide their information to receive a hard copy of the draft plan in the mail, if interested. After the introductory station (see 1 & 2) below, each section of the open house provided opportunities to provide comments or input. The open house stations were:

Three of the priority projects are community driven: Hō'ākeolapono Trades Academy and Institute: Home Building Resource Center, Makai Management Plan, and Anahola Place-Based Education Network; each of these stations had a community champion or point of contact to answer questions and encourage beneficiaries to sign-up to kōkua with the future implementation. Two priority projects



require DHHL to lead implementation efforts: Surface Water Resource Management and Mauka Farm Lot Implementation; DHHL staff were available to answer questions, gather feedback and encourage beneficiaries to sign-up to support implementation at these stations. Project team staff were also floating between stations to listen to feedback and answer questions.

5. Maintain reservoirs for flood control – control the overflow system
  6. Old ditch system goes all the way to the Bay
  7. All other water system in Anahola are pumped, the reservoir system is gravity (Read Sugar Water book)
  8. Mauka intakes (on DLNR land) are in good condition – can open up the ‘auwai relatively inexpensively
  9. Removal of albizia in mauka lands is now causing a runoff issue. Green energy left stumps in – DHHL should remove the stumps and use the material to build dams to stop runoff
