

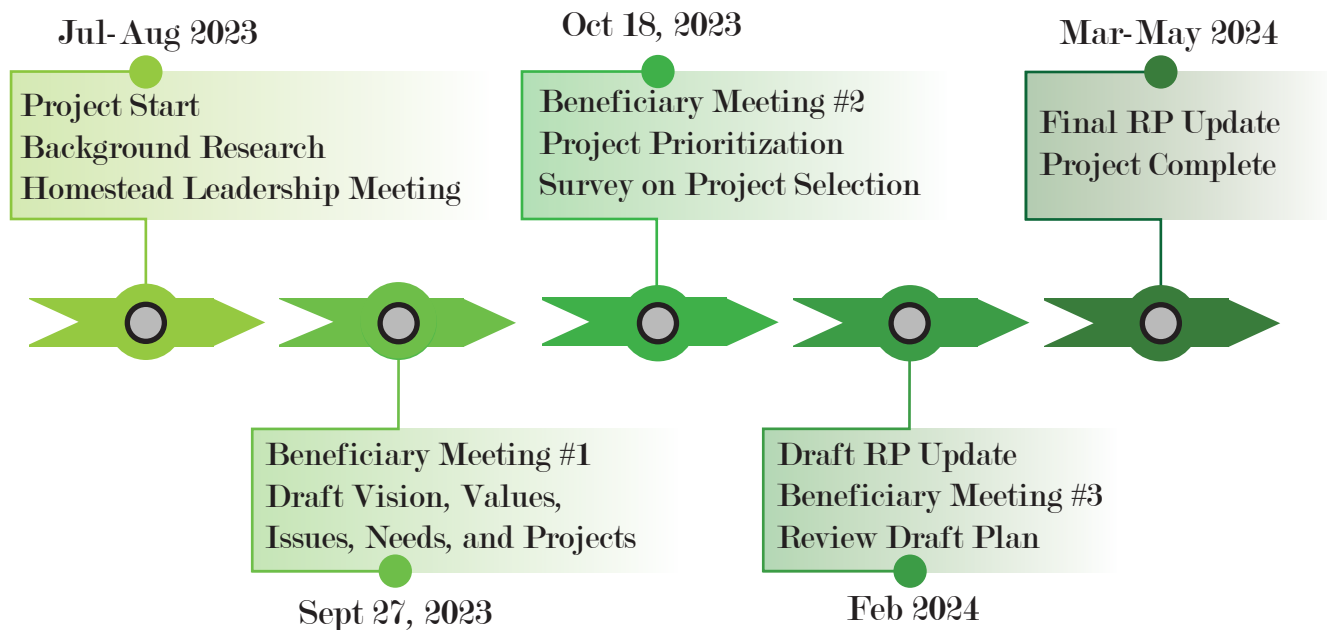

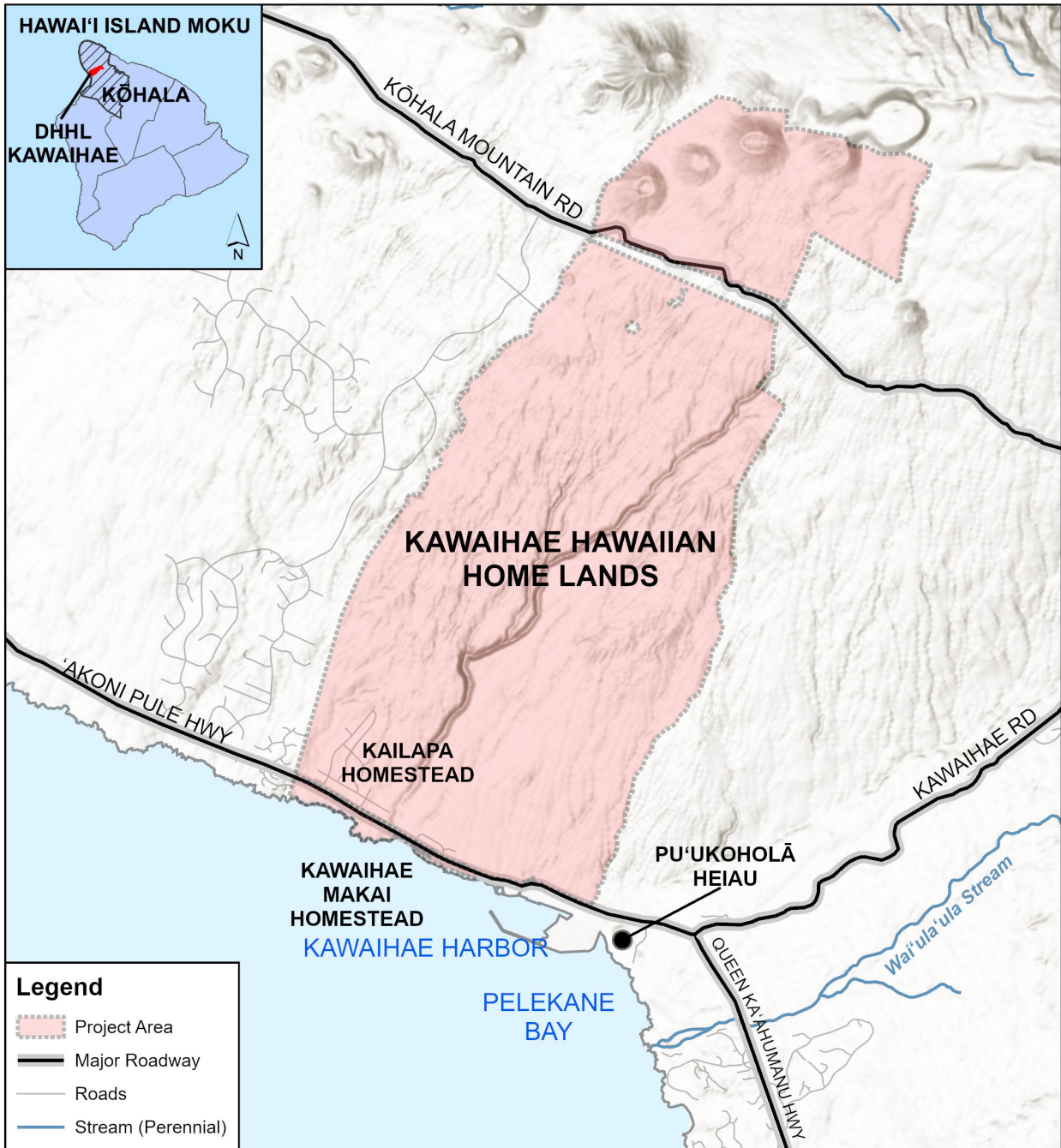
Kawaihae Regional Plan Update

Regional Plans are a part of the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands' tiered Planning system, and focus at the homestead community and regional level. Regional Plans are prepared through extensive beneficiary engagement and are approved by the Hawaiian Homes Commission. Across the islands, there are a total of 23 Regional Plans, and the last Kawaihae Regional Plan was adopted in 2010. This update to the Kawaihae Regional Plan will include three (3) beneficiary consultations where a vision, community values, and priority projects will be identified. The Regional Planning process is meant to help build capacity and a sense of community, stimulate partnerships that aid the homestead community in reaching their goals, and give beneficiaries an opportunity to work together with DHHL in planning for their future.
