SEALED BIDS for IFB No.: IFB-24-HHL-011, R & M OF STREETLIGHTS AND SIGNS IN VARIOUS DHHL SUBDIVISIONS ON OAHU, ISLAND OF OAHU, State of Hawaii, will be received by the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands (DHHL), at Hale Kalaniana'ole, 91-5420 Kapolei Parkway, Kapolei, Hawaii 96707, until **2:00 p.m., Hawaii Standard Time (H.S.T.) March 26, 2024** at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the time fixed for opening or delivered anywhere other than as specified above will not be considered.

This project consists of electrical and street light maintenance at various DHHL Subdivisions on the Island of Oahu. Tasks include replacing burnt-out street light lamps and ballasts with LED equivalents, swapping inoperable photocells, and replacing damaged steel street light standards and arms upon DHHL request. Additionally, electrical troubleshooting will be conducted to diagnose electrical problems and perform necessary repairs, ensuring proper street light operation. The Contractor will also be responsible for troubleshooting, repairing, and resetting problems with the Carmanah Speedcheck Solar signs.

To be eligible to submit a bid, the Bidder and/or his subcontractors shall possess all required valid State of Hawaii licenses and specialty licenses needed to perform the work for this project. This project is subject to Section 103-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS"), and to the payment of not less than the wages paid to public officers and employees for similar work.

A properly executed and notarized STANDARD QUALIFICATION QUESTIONNAIRE FOR OFFERORS, SPO Form-21 ("Questionnaire") is required and shall be submitted to the DHHL Land Development Division, at 91-5420 Kapolei Parkway, Kapolei, Hawaii 96707 no later than **4:30 p.m., H.S.T., March 18, 2024**. Completed Questionnaires must be submitted as an original hard copy with wet signatures. Questionnaires that are submitted via facsimile or E-mail **will not** be accepted. 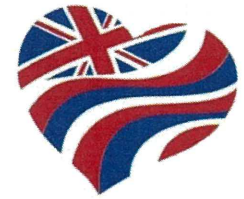
