Ka La‘i Ola - Lahaina

Mauka of Leiali‘i Homestead

From Honoapi‘ilani Hwy, Turn on to Leiali‘i Parkway,
Left on to Cane Haul Road

Parking along Cane Haul Road.



Pu‘uhona - Waikapū

136 Pōhāko‘i Loop

Mauka of Honoapi‘ilani Highway,
approx. 0.2 miles north of the Pilikana Street
intersection and approx. 0.7 miles south of the Kuikahi
Drive intersection.

Enter through the black dust fence onto the unpaved
construction access road and follow the people directing
traffic on the project site.



Kamalani – Kīhei

Cul-de-sac at the end of Kamahiwa Parkway

From Piilani Highway (State Hwy 31) turn left onto
Kaiwahine St, then left onto Kamahiwa Parkway.

Enter the gated dirt lot on the right.
