DUTIES SUMMARY:

The position serves as branch chief of the Technical Services Branch in the Land Management Division and is responsible for conducting land and real property appraisals and reviewing appraisals made by others; conducting special studies; and developing and maintaining a comprehensive inventory of DHHL lands and holdings; and recording land transactions.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Education

Graduation from an accredited four (4) year college or university with a bachelor's degree in economics, land economics, public planning, public administration, business administration, financing, or a related field.

Specialized Experience

Four and one-half (4.5) years of progressively responsible professional experience in land and real property appraisal work. Such experience should demonstrate possession of Hawaii land laws, real estate laws and terminology, real property appraisal process, various types of land titles and legal instruments affecting land transactions; and the ability to gather and analyze land transaction data, to prepare reports of findings, including conclusions and recommendations, and to meet and deal effectively with others.

Quality of Experience

Possession of the required number of years of experience will not in itself be accepted as proof of qualification for a position. The applicant's overall experience must have been of such scope and level of responsibility as to conclusively demonstrate that he/she has the ability to perform the duties of the position for which he/she is being considered.
